

**SERIES: #SNOWBALL**

SERIES MAIN IDEA: When we are saved we become NEW creations, but we still fight a losing battle against our FLESH. This is what makes us continue to sin even when we hate it. This is why God has given us a spirit to lead us and win the battle for us.

SERIES MAIN TEXT: Romans 7:20

20 Now if I do what I do not want to do, it is no longer I who do it, but it is sin living in me that does it.

Romans 7:25 Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!

BOTTOM LINE

We will always fight our flesh and the only way we win is if we follow the spirit

LEADER NOTES

- Open up by asking your students how their THANKSGIVING was and what they took away from the sermon.
- RECAP the meanings of the words FLESH, SIN, LAW, & SPIRIT.
- ASK if anything was unclear.
- **ASK if anyone made a DECISION**

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. **ICEBREAKER: What's your favorite EPIC BATTLE? (Could be biblical or from a book or movie)**
2. **Who usually always wins in a battle GOOD or EVIL?**
3. **Thinking about the battle between you and your flesh: Why do you think your flesh will always win over you?**
4. **What are some lies that your flesh tells you about sin?**
5. **Have you ever experienced the SPIRIT trying to warn you about sin?**
6. **SIN is sneaking and stronger than us, but God has given His spirit to us to help us. One way is by warning you about what sin you struggle with. What are some boundaries that are good to protect you from sin that you struggle with.**

Pray for one another throughout the week as we battle the flesh and choose the power of the spirit.
