

Pastor's Pen...

By now, the decorations are down, the Christmas tree has either been carried out to the dump or put back into storage, and we are settling back into a normal rhythm. Have you ever stopped and considered what that really means? I looked up a few of the synonyms for normal: standard, regular, ordinary, typical, routine, average...

Is that what we want our lives to be, just average? Well, average is certainly better than below average, but is that what we should be aiming for in 2019? If we're honest, I believe average is the last thing that you want your life to be, but that is often what we end up settling for simply because we don't take God at his word. Listen to what Jesus said:

I tell you for certain that if you have faith in me, you will do the same things that I am doing. You will do even greater things, now that I am going back to the Father.

John 14:12 (CEB)

Jesus wasn't just blowing smoke here and the words that He spoke to the disciples then, he speaks to us today. God has greater things for you and greater things that He longs to do through you.
