## The Daily Walk

I am a creature of habit... for years my routine has been to rise early, spend time in the Word, and then to exercise before heading off to work. Part of that early morning exercise routine has been to put in some cardio time either on the Max Climber or by walking through the neighborhood, usually before the sun comes up. This morning I was running a little behind schedule and the sun was already breaking over the horizon as I headed out the door.

It was the same walk I've been taking for the last seven years; same route and the same pace through every season but this morning everything seemed different. I could hear birds singing. I could see the flowers blooming. The dew was sparkling on the grass and beauty was all around me. Maybe it was simply because it was light enough to see things that usually go unnoticed in the dark or I was more conscious of my surroundings than usual. Whichever one it was, God began to speak to me on my walk.

"It's a beautiful day, isn't it." To which I replied, "Yes it is Lord. Thank you." "Most of the time you are too busy putting one foot in front of the other to notice. In the process, you are missing a lot." I knew what He was saying to me was true but I also knew that He was talking about more than taking time to smell the flowers.

"Steve, you take this walk every other day and today you noticed them simply because it was light enough for you to see and appreciate what was there all along. But, you know what else you've been overlooking and unaware of?" What Lord? "Me. Every time you take this walk, I am walking with you."
