So Grateful...We Are Debt Free!

What a summer this has been! We have so much to be thankful for I don't even know where to begin. At the beginning of the year, we felt that we would be able to pay our debt off by the end of the year and thanks to the faithful generosity of people like you, we have seen God help us wipe out our debt far ahead of schedule! **We are debt free!** Let me say that again just so I am sure that you heard it...

WE ARE DEBT FREE! I cannot tell you how good it feels to be able to say that but I am sure that many of you who have carried this burden way longer than I have actually understand and feel it at a much deeper level than most. So you might be asking, *"Now what? How are we going to celebrate this?"*

First, on October the 1st, we will burn the note as a part of the worship celebration and give God the glory. And, we will thank God for the things He has done and begin to look forward to the things He is going to do in the future.

Second, we will be officially retiring our Moving Mountains Campaign for the debt reduction. Once again, let me say to each who has made this possible over the years, "Thank you for your faithful sacrifice. For those who have faithfully given to our Moving Mountains Campaign, let me encourage you to continue to invest in our vision to *Help People Find and Follow Jesus* by giving to the unified budget.

Third, we will continue to seek God's leading for the future. While we do not know what those opportunities may be, I do know that God wants us to be ready for them when they come. Two years ago, God led me to write this in our October 2021 newsletter and I feel it even more strongly today than I did then.

What does that mean for us? First, it means that we need to know the heart of God and feel absolute freedom to invest His gifts wherever we can, even if we risk failure. But beyond that, it means that if we want more responsibility, more privilege, and more Kingdom fruit—we need to be faithful with what He gives and look for new ways to grow what we've been given. That is the Master's basis for rewarding His servants with more; they had been faithful with the amounts they had in their hands.
