No matter what the circumstances, grief is a painful, confusing process. A GriefShare group is a safe, welcoming place where people understand the difficult emotions of grief.

At this 13-week support group program, you'll discover what to expect in the days ahead and what's "normal" in grief. Since there are no neat, orderly stages of grief, you'll learn helpful ways of coping with grief, in all its unpredictability—and gain solid support each step of the way. At each weekly meeting, you will view a video featuring respected counselors, pastors, and healthcare professionals on grief-related topics, plus you'll hear relatable personal stories of grief. After that is a small-group discussion to allow people time to talk, share support, and personally apply what they learned on the video.

As most of you know I grew up in a middle-class family in Birmingham, Alabama. My father, Charles, was a fireman & homebuilder and my mom, Barbara, taught kindergarten at our local church. I have one sibling, my older brother David, who is the lead pastor today at First Baptist Pinson, Alabama. Overall, it was a normal upbringing, except the *spiritual leader* of my home was not my dad. He was too busy to bother with attending church & left that responsibility to my mom. My mother made sure David & I were at church every time the doors were open. It seemed like I spent more time at church, than I did anywhere else, even my own home.

As a young boy I always wondered why church was so important to my mom but meant so little to my dad. Now, as a husband & father myself I realize how valuable the spiritual role & responsibility of the father is. God designed & created every man to take the responsibility as the spiritual leader of his home. For way too long men have sat on the sidelines & have let the mothers fill that role for their family. Men, it's time to step up & fill the role & responsibility that God has called you to.

Statistics say that when kids come to Christ first, 3.5% of families will follow. When mom comes to Christ first, 17% of families will follow. But when dad comes to Christ first, 93% of families will follow.
